Education

Become the most educated big city in the nation

Indicator

Chicagoans over age 25 with at least an Associates degree increased to 40% - our goal is to increase to 50%



Outcomes

13% is the graduation rate at the City Colleges of Chicago, up from 7% three years ago, and on track to double again in the next four years

3,488 industry-recognized credentials were earned by Career and Technical Education students in CPS

Outputs

- Enrolled 636 students in Early College STEM Schools in 2014, on track to 3,400 by 2020
- 45 schools to participate in Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment next year - up 50% from last year



Healthcare

Improve the health of the public—especially the vulnerable—through a financially sustainable healthcare system

Indicator

The Cook County diabetes incidence rate decreased to 8.5% in 2011 - our goal is to reduce to 6.9%



Outcomes

95,000 vulnerable adults enrolled in CountyCare with access to primary and preventative care for the first time

\$76M reduction in local tax funding to CCHHS in fiscal year 2014. Local taxes contributed just 15% of CCHHS's total budget in 2014, down from 50% in 2006

Outputs

- Second cohort of nurse and operations managers graduated from leadership academy
- Call center pilot program cut unanswered patient phone calls in half at Cook County Health & Hospitals System



Public Safety

Make Chicago the safest big city in the nation

Indicator

Violent crimes per 100 thousand residents decreased to under 1,000 in 2012 - our goal is to cut this rate in half



Outputs

- Leadership of GetInChicago (formerly Public Safety Action Committee) transitioned to permanent staff
- GetInChicago launched 2014 letter of intent to award \$3.5 million for programming
- GetInChicago awarded up to \$2 million to 11 non-profit organizations, with the remainder of the funding to be announced in fall 2014
- Established legal foundation to exchange criminal justice data critical to Cook County
- Developed benchmark best practices to increase youth employment by the private sector



Economic Growth

Become a global center for talent, capital and enterprise

Indicator

Chicago's metro employment increased to 3.8M in 2013 - our goal is to accelerate growth to employ 4.3M



Outcomes

\$70M in taxpayer savings from City-County collaboration realized.

48M tourists visited Chicago in 2013, the most on record, bringing Chicago closer to its goal of 55M

\$1B is the estimated investment the Lucas Museum of Narrative Art will make in Chicago, enabled by Civic Consulting support of the Site Selection Task Force

Outputs

- Developed first comprehensive economic impact study of Chicago's 585 parks to direct future Park District investments
- Released Chicago's first comprehensive technology plan
