Chicago is getting noticed at the federal level for its efforts to rapidly expand the network of Community Violence Intervention (CVI) programs.

Civic Consulting Alliance has supported the growth of CVI among multiple clients, including the **Partnership for Safe and Peaceful Communities** (PSPC). Members of PSPC were recently invited to a meeting with the Department of Justice (DOJ) and other stakeholders to discuss CVI.

The recent Sun-Times article, "<u>Justice</u> <u>Department officials take interest in,</u> <u>praise Chicago anti-violence</u> <u>programs</u>" explains why the DOJ's

plan to invest \$100 million for antiviolence programs will be modeled in part on the programs that cover Chicago's most violent neighborhoods. The Civic Committee of the Commercial Club of Chicago has announced an ambitious goal to make Chicago the safest big city in America.

We're proud to support the design, launch, and initial phases of work for the Civic Committee's new Public Safety Task Force, a coordinated effort that aligns the business community, public sector, and social impact organizations with shared plans, goals, and metrics to sustainably reduce violence.

The recent Chicago Tribune editorial, "Curbing violent crime is an all-hands-ondeck task. That must include corporate Chicago" is complimentary of the initiative, stating, "There's good reason to feel optimistic about the Civic Committee's new mission. To begin with, the group's game plan makes sense."

## Share your environmental priorities with Chicago's Office of Environmental Equity

Chicago's Office of Climate and Environmental Equity (OCEE) is conducting external outreach to gain feedback as part of an environmental governance study and wants to hear from YOU. <u>This public survey</u> will help the City gain insights into how to best organize Chicago's environmental functions and operations.

The survey is open from June 12- July 2, 2023, and offered in 5 languages: English, Spanish, Polish, Arabic, and Chinese.

Last year only 37 of 77 outdoor pools were open. This summer, all pools are on track to provide youth with positive spaces to play!

Earlier this year, Chicago Park District reached out to Civic Consulting Alliance for advice and thought partnership to organize a cross-departmental effort to ensure they meet their goal to open all pools.

The coaching we provided builds off an organizational assessment that was completed with our *pro bono* partner **West Monroe**, which identified a roadmap of initiatives that advance cultural change within the Aquatics Division.


